# SMOKE FREE POLICY

### Rationale:

The South Australian Softball Association recognizes that passive smoking is hazardous to health and that non-smokers should be protected from tobacco smoke.

Accordingly, the following policy devised by the South Australian Softball Association applies to Softball Headquarters, West Beach, as from 30<sup>th</sup> April 2003.

### Policy on Smoking:

The South Australian Softball Association's policy requires –

- administration, bar, clubrooms and office areas to remain smoke-free
- toilet facilities to remain smoke-free
- cigarettes are not sold at this venue (status quo)
- hiring out of venue will be smoke-free
- outdoor spectator grandstands and seated areas to be smoke-free
- all social functions (including junior events, dinners, fund-raising events, meetings) of the organization to be smoke-free
- coaches, trainers, volunteers and officials are to refrain from smoking while they are acting in an official capacity
- players to refrain from smoking whilst participating in warm up and games
- effects of smoking on performances to be included in education of junior players
- smoke-free behaviour to be incorporated into the code of behaviour for coaches and players

### Non-compliance:

Non-compliance with this policy may result in appropriate action being taken by the Board. Anyone wishing to discuss any aspect of this policy is invited to contact a member of the Board. Your co-operation is greatly appreciated.

### Policy Review:

The policy on smoking will be reviewed annually.
